

## Immunization Information

All children “enrolled” in school, whether they are attending school remotely due to the pandemic or are attending classes in person, are required to submit immunization records and exemptions.

Please continue to follow the immunization schedules for your children. This is critical in keeping vaccine-preventable diseases from resurfacing. Please call your healthcare provider or nearby school-based health center if you are due for regular vaccinations.

## 21-22 School Year: Changes to Immunization Exemption Process

Due to the passing of new legislation (SB20-163) there are changes to the exemption process for the new school year.

Go to the vaccine exemption page at [www.colorado.gov/vaccineexemption](http://www.colorado.gov/vaccineexemption) .

**Option 1:** A parent can download the "Certificate of Non-Medical Exemption", complete it and have their immunizing health care provider sign it and submit to the school. All non-medical exemptions expire 06/30 of the current school year. Medical exemptions do not expire.

**Option 2:** The Online Immunization Education Module is available for parents who do not want to have a HCP signature. The Certificate of Non-Medical exemption provided at the end of the course does NOT have to be signed by a HCP. Once complete, submit certificate to the school.
