 - Runs social groups to help students identify and manage emotions
 - BESS Emotional Screener (Fall/Spring) 3-5 grade
 - In the fall we used the data to collect information about which kids would benefit from a social emotional group
 - o Additional .5 M/M Special Education
 - Looking to hire another .5 M/M
 - We are at about 10 -11%
 - With our current caseload we need assistance in order to comply with minutes
 - Will receive budget assistance from the district

- Specials Plan
 - We are losing Spanish in 4th/5th
 - Ms. Nonino will be full time
 - We will have a staff member who will push in an provide Spanish instruction
 - Also trying to have more Spanish enrichment after school and providing scholarships
 - This also helps with budgeting
